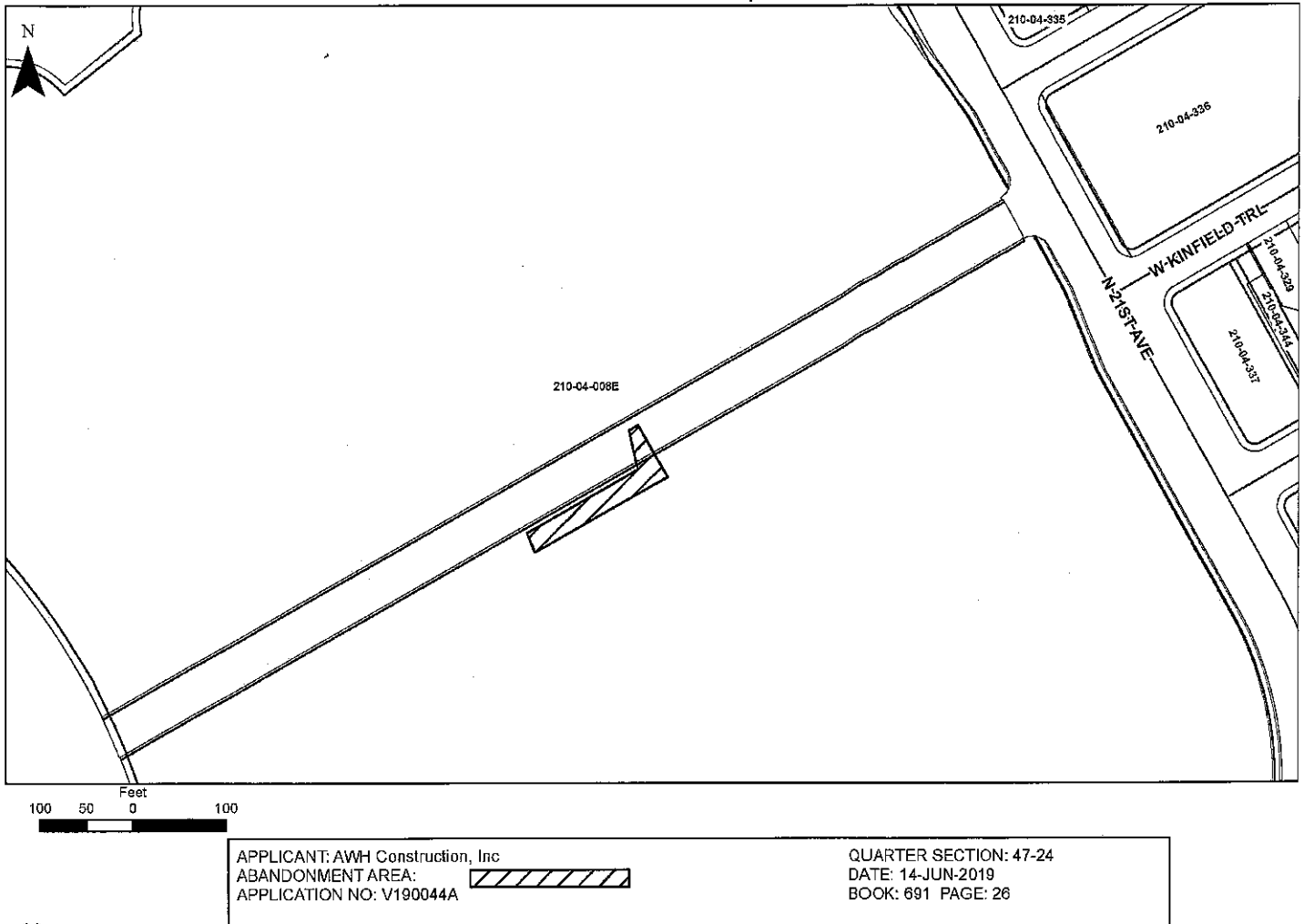
Request to abandon:

City Staff Comments and Recommendations

PDD Civil Reviewer: Recommend denial of the drainage easement abandonment request. Drainage easements define limits of inundation for the 100-year storm event and the City will not recommend abandoning these drainage easements without justification supported by a drainage report from the civil engineer. If the applicant desires to abandon a portion of this drainage easement, then they need to provide a drainage report showing no adverse impacts to upstream and downstream properties. The drainage report will provide hydrological and hydraulic information.


Stipulations of Conditional Approval
