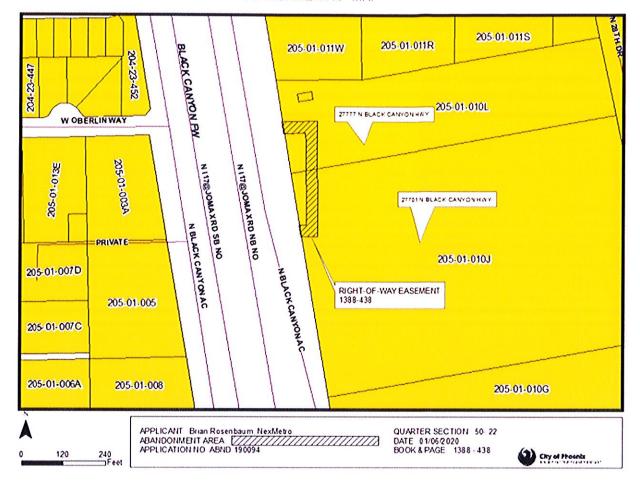

Hearing Summary

Mr. Christopher DePerro, the Abandonment Hearing Officer opened the hearing and provided instructions.

Ms. Emily Dawson, the Abandonment Coordinator, read the case into the record.

Mr. Christopher DePerro, then turned the discussion over to the applicant.

Mr. Jared Geisler, with NexMetro Communities introduced himself for the record. Mr. Geisler then went on to explain that NexMetro acquired the property in January of 2019, has been working with City Staff on redeveloping the property for the past 18 months plus. Mr. Geisler has been working with City Staff to develop of 211-unit multifamily project and has been coordinating to modify the existing sewer easement on the property as well as add in a new water line. Through the development process, we were not notified about the patent easement on site but is shown on City maps which is why the application was submitted. The patent easement does affect with some of the structures, so we are requesting that it is removed.

Mr. Geisler did request that drafted stipulation number 1 be removed, because of the existing sewer line in place and the newly dedicated water easement.

The Hearing Officer granted a Conditional Approval with revised stipulations.

Stipulations of Conditional Approval

The request of abandonment, is conditionally approved by the Abandonment Hearing Officer. The following stipulations will need to be met:

- 1. Either a or b shall be complied with:
 - a. All utilities other than water and sewer shall be relocated to locations approved by each affected utility company. All work is to be done by each affected utility company at no expense to the affected utility company. Water and sewer may remain as long as they are located within the separately dedicated water and sewer easement.
 - b. All right-of-way shall be retained as a public utilities easement with 24-hour vehicle maintenance access.

2. All stipulations must be completed within **one year** from the Abandonment Hearing Officer's decision.
