### Hearing Summary

Mr. Christopher DePerro, the Abandonment Hearing Officer, called the hearing to order at 9:32 am on April 14, 2022.

Ms. Maggie Dellow, the Abandonment Coordinator introduced the abandonment case ABND 220005 by reading the abandonment case into the record by stating the applicant, location, abandonment request, and purpose of the request, as well as City staff research.

Mr. DePerro then started the discussion by asking the applicant if they would like to add any additional comments regarding the abandonment request.

Mr. Huellmantel, the applicant, explained that the proposed project at this location would be affordable housing and that the City had expressed interest in removing this piece of right-of-way as it was old and useless. Mr. Huellmantel explained that the goal in abandoning the right-of-way easement is to unencumber the west side of 34<sup>th</sup> Ave and landscape it, while having the east side of 34<sup>th</sup> Ave function as an alleyway.

Ms. Dellow reviewed the city staff and utility provider comments received during the review period. Ms. Dellow then reviewed the staff recommended stipulations of approval.

Mr. DePerro explained that in order to convert the right-of-way on the east side of Moreland to an alley, a resolution would need to be sent to City Council. This would be handled by the City at the time of final abandonment approval.

The Hearing Officer granted a conditional approval subject to stipulations in the staff report with a revision to stipulation #1.

#### **Stipulations of Conditional Approval**

The request of abandonment is conditionally approved by the Abandonment Hearing Officer. The following stipulations will need to be met:

- 1. Developer shall construct a 45-foot-radius knuckle at the intersection of 34th Avenue and Moreland Street and provide a driveway. In this circumstance, the 30-feet east of the monument line shall be designated by resolution as a public alley. The alley shall be paved to local street standards.
- 2. None of the existing right-of-way dedicated in fee title for 34th Avenue and Moreland Street may be abandoned.
- 3. All stipulations must be completed within two years from the Abandonment Hearing Officer's decision.
