
The Community Spread Benchmarks

ADHS defines community spread levels with the weekly thresholds outlined below:

Benchmarks	Minimal	Moderate	Substantial
Cases	< 10 cases/100k	10-100 cases/100k	> 100 cases/100k
Percent Positivity	< 5%	5-10% *	> 10%
COVID-like Illness	< 5%	5-10%	> 10%

Testing Positivity in Maricopa County

The following information is reported by the Arizona Department of Health Services COVID-19 Dashboard for laboratory testing. The data has been filtered to depict to its lowest jurisdictional level, in this case Maricopa County, and reported on 09/29/2020.



Reopening Benchmarks

Arizona Department of Health Services has established three specific community benchmarks to determine the risk to COVID-19. The results are updated weekly using a dashboard created by Maricopa County Department of Public Health and maintained on their website. The dashboard can be filtered by School District, City or Zip Code

The benchmarks established for each level are:

- Daily cases per 100,000 people
- Percentage of Positive Tests (Positivity)
- COVID-Like Illnesses in Hospitals
