Hearing Summary

Mr. Christopher DePerro, the Abandonment Hearing Officer calls the meeting to order on October 13, 2022. He asks Ms. Alyssa Neitzel, the Abandonment Coordinator to introduce the case 220052.

Ms. Alyssa Neitzel, introduced abandonment ABND 220052 and read the case into the record by stating the applicant, location, and purpose of the request, as well as City staff research.

Mr. DePerro then started the discussion by asking the applicant if they would like to add any additional comments regarding the abandonment request.

Mr. Shaun Auronas responds.

Ms. Alyssa Neitzel reads stipulation recommendations from various city departments as well as stipulations of approval.

Ms. Maja Brkovic, Streets Transportation Department Representative, reads comments.

Mr. DePerro reads recommended stipulations and revises number 1 to state "prior to completion of the abandonment, the applicant shall officially relinquish the approved P-1 zoning approved with case Z-28-982." Number 3 will be renamed as number 2.

The Hearing Officer grants conditional approval subject to stipulations with modifications.

Stipulations of Conditional Approval

The request of abandonment is conditionally approved by the Abandonment Hearing Officer. The following stipulations will need to be met:

- 1. Prior to completion of the abandonment, the applicant shall officially relinquish the approved P-1 zoning approved with case Z-289-82.
- 2. No right-of-way within 30-feet of the 37th Street monument line may be abandoned.
- 3. No right-of-way within 25-feet of the 38th Street monument line may be abandoned.
- 4. All stipulations must be completed within **two years** from the Abandonment Hearing Officer's decision.

This conditional approval has been reviewed and approved by the Abandonment Hearing Officer.
